A Blind Man's Guide to Prophecy

So really, I wrote all this specifically for those who want to understand prophecy and are pretty well clueless of how to do that. But in fact, everything here is very helpful for anyone who is a Christian or wants to live to see God. Everyone will find many things they never understood or didn't know.

Everybody wants to know the future before it happens. Everybody. Some look to computers or Economists, others look in the liver...and still others, perhaps like you, look to God. We want to know the future to make a lot of money or to be safe or maybe because we want to feel that we are part of what is happening in the future. We want to know because we are afraid of what may happen in the unknown future and want to avoid bad things. We want to know because we want to make ourselves big or very rarely small. We want to know because we want to know the next big thing. Occasionally we want to know because we just want to know about God and what He's doing. This is the best motivation, perhaps the only living one. The word and spirit of God and the Bible or "open scroll" are the only real sources of true prophecy in the world. Revelation was given to John because God loved him. John was like a little child. He loved God and opened his eyes and his heart to whatever God gave him...even though he understood very little of it within his own context. He saw things he couldn't describe. Things for which no words existed at that time. So we have descriptions that are surreal and with added translation issues...nearly impossible to "see" as a picture except when we are so close to it that it does kind of make sense.

But <u>seeing</u> is what prophecy is all about. It is all about stereo vision and hope and a way forward regardless of the conditions around us. And when I say the word vision...I do not mean some personal dream or vision...I mean actual sight kinda like using your eyeballs. God has much to say about this and Christ Himself was our greatest prophet though we do not generally consider Him so. Even though it is kinda...Duhhh obvious. All of it is His word. He spoke more about future people and motivations than strange grand events all but unseen in the future. But He <u>did</u> speak of these and far more than people think and He inspired others to speak even more of them whether before He came down to us or after He returned to heaven. There are many things that we must have within us to understand prophecy and to see the future but the absolute primary one is actually very simple and is explained in the next section.

There is a question that you must ask yourself before you proceed. And, you must answer it completely honestly. Don't look ahead for the answer; answer it and then read on.

Do you absolutely believe the words that you read in the Bible? And that they are absolute truth!

Not...do you believe your own interpretation or doctrine or understanding?...Not...do you believe it is an interesting historical document?...Do you believe the actual words in front of you that you are reading when you open the Bible? And that they are Gods words. Do you believe that they are all immutably and completely inarguably true? If there is the slightest fudge or hesitation in your answer then your lack of faith is apparent. Perhaps only to yourself in this moment but know that it is true, regardless of your acknowledgment. Most people educated in Bible History and or the seminary will just need to answer no as they have largely been led far from belief. Most churchgoing people will answer in the affirmative and with an "of course..." But if they listen deep inside themselves there is usually an exception here or there for a variety of reasons. For others, the fudge may not be apparent

until later when they are confronted with a prophecy that they just won't believe because it slays too many sacred cows, even perhaps themselves. For others including the "formally educated" the Bible is a story book or historical document and these people should stop reading here, as you are in danger of becoming either a heretic or a believer; at least then you would be hot or cold. Fence-sitters die when confronted with prophecy or a prophet, especially in the end time.

Here is another question that must be answered. *What was Jesus Christ's first title?* The first name He ever used?

What is the name that He had first and foremost before any other name?

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

His primary title, His very origin is the **WORD**. God the Father split off a chunk of Himself to mold His Son and He chose His Word as the beginning of His own Son. The Bible is His Book. How likely is it that **God**, named the WORD, is going to lie or that there are any lies in the Bible, His Book? The answer is unequivocally NONE! If there is the slightest hedge or fudge in your spirit when you comprehend this...then you have automatically and unconsciously done a number of things.

- 1. You have limited God's power and decided that He is not omnipotent.
- 2. You have called God a liar.
- 3. You have breached your own faith and made it void.
- 4. Reduced any possibility of understanding any prophecy to zero.

If you have done those things above...repent or die. The only possibility of any error or lie in the Bible is limited to mans interference or misunderstanding. Read the fourth and third to last verses of the Bible with your belief engaged.

If you could not read the above and answer those questions completely honestly in faith. Then you should stop reading here and re-evaluate what you believe...find out where you went wrong and start over or or failing that simply fall away into darkness. If you did make it through...you should continue on and see what else may stand between you and God. If you need further affirmation of these things, you should do your own personal study on lies and truth. "God hates a lie"...etc. Very basic, not hard "...Sanctify them through your truth; your word is truth..." Thousands of scriptures to choose from. If you do not believe it deep down in the uttermost parts of your soul; you are unlikely to understand prophecy because you haven't committed to faith and belief therefore anything you build on will fall off its sandy foundation when you start to understand prophecy.

"Behold, ye despisers, and wonder, and perish: <u>for I work a work in your days</u>, <u>a work which ye</u> shall in no wise believe, though a man declare it unto you."

Your belief is directly in question and if it is not solid, you will not believe and in lacking belief you will not act in the manner of one that has understanding and comprehends what is going on around him. You will be that shell-shocked person who in a <u>national scale life threatening disaster</u>, cannot function and still tries to go to work when nothing logically indicates you should. Prophecy requires not only faith and belief but action. Faith without works is dead! Prophecy by nature requires action...of the prophet...but also by the hearer.

"And they, whether they will hear, or whether they will forbear, (for they are a rebellious house,) yet shall know that there hath been a prophet among them."

Any time that someone hears a real and true prophecy there are several things that by the nature of the circumstance will happen.

First: The prophecy, the spoken command of God usually in confrontation and direct opposition to the interests of the people being prophesied to. They will feel it in the depths of their soul. It will pierce as an arrow and it will tingle inside their spirit.

Second: They have a choice...feeling it within them does not mean that the person believes it in faith, but The Truth has pierced their soul and whether they do hear and obey the voice of the Lord their God as it comes from another person or whether they forbear (ignore, choose not to listen) and convince themselves it is not so...will be judged before God in the judgment. "I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick [living] and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom;" not that they might not be judged by a man unto death prior to this final judgment... "And it shall come to pass, that every soul, which will not hear that prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people."

Third: There is a window of time established by the act of the prophet. This is variable and may span the distance between Adam and now or it may be the amount of time between the words leaving Peter's mouth and Sapphira falling down dead in a moment, for an act committed in the past.

Fourth: as you saw above, there is the fruition of the prophecy or the act of God that was prophesied, in this case death and death. To show the example of life to it's fruition is more complicated but certainly possible.

Prophecy is composed of two major things that we all know and understand. There is a point or purpose for any prophecy, <u>a lesson and a point of decision</u> and it is always part of God's plan to correct or change people when and as He wants it done. God makes His point clearly every time. The two things that prophecy are composed of are familiar because they are dictated by our very own humanity...and a thing that God is very, very familiar with and you understand if you have read your Bible much at all. *These 2 things are the carrot and the stick*. And just as our humanity demands in everyday life...the stick is vastly more common and useful around men. Thus, most prophecy in the Bible is STICK! And for good reason. It keeps the ass between the carrot and the stick moving forward. Uh, yep...that's you and your herd-mates. If this rather mundane reality of life offends you...too bad. Truth is truth.

There are also a large number of difficulties, pitfalls, points to ponder, stumbling blocks, necessities and traps within the realm of prophesy and understanding the future. These following points are not really separated by who the prophet is or the prophesyee (hmm...the person being prophesied to or we could just say jackass...for virtually all intents and purposes, true) is...or he who is trying to understand a written prophecy.

First...false prophecy. Really, really easy to decide that you are important and that you know things and that you understand the Bible and are wiser than those around you...etc. etc. etc. These days if you have much of anything to say about prophecy you can make a lot of money if you say it smoothly and in a calculated way that sounds good. Especially if you find your own little metaphor and interpret it for everyone based lightly upon a single verse or possibly two. Write a book or a series of books...have a website...lots of traffic...sell religious products of every kind...attract followers...collect tithes...etc. etc. There's not really much downside because you control the forum and can pooh

pooh anyone that makes trouble...segregate them...ostracize them...minimize the damage to keep it from spreading and boom, business as usual. There are many scriptures for this business but this isn't a paper about false prophecy, anti-christs and moneychangers...though it is tempting. Just realize that this above is not prophecy. This is lies. This is now a short road that ends in a fall and weeping and gnashing of teeth. Some got away with it for a lifetime...now that is no longer the case.

Second, there is no room for foolishness or joking. It is deadly serious and words can kill; very, very occasionally something like the ass comments above work simply because the more serious you are, and the more you understand, the less funny it is and the more true it becomes. Words can kill...You or the person being spoken to, or random people around you that may suffer from your tongue. Look up Jephthah. Do not think that Jephthah was not a prophet of his own life. Do not think that the words you speak about prophecy will not be considered by those around you or that *your judgement* of **His words** will not have consequences. Do not think that the drivel coming out of your mouth is not heard and remembered. "That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned." And yes every idle word spoken or written or sung. If that doesn't scare you then **you should really stop reading this paper** as you will be responsible for a significant amount more in the judgment and not to your credit.

Third, the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom! Not the middle of wisdom...not the end of wisdom...not the great swelling out of the strength of much wisdom...but the beginning. Without the fear of God...you are twice dead, a broken sack of body parts lacking everything required to gain eternal life. Fear not him that can kill the body, but Him who can kill the body and soul in hell. Nothing can soften this or make it other than what it is. Love is not an antidote to the fear of God. In fact, for a human to truly feel the perfect love of God requires fear of God. Without the fear of God, all that remains is the vicious slide into contempt of God and man while embracing false emotion and advertising it and lying to those around you for truly selfish reasons, money or self-aggrandizement or whatever. This is why your children disobey indiscriminately...no fear of their father. Without the fear of God there is no faith...there is no humility...there is no love or joy or happiness...there is the hollowness of personal lack. A seeking without finding at the very best. There is only pride and selfsatisfaction that ends in death. This must be absolutely understood by anyone seeking God for any reason or there will never be that absolutely sensational feeling of finding God or knowing God or understanding Him or His words in the depth of truth. The fear of God is the only antidote for hypocrisy and hypocrites are allergic to the fear of God. They can't stand it and won't tolerate it. The fear of God is also the only thing that will bring true faith. Faith brings the love of God through understanding of who God is and what He is doing. It seems that everyone understands the love of God and has something to say about it. Not all of it is purely false...but most of it is. The fear of God comes consequently with the love of God. No fear, equals false love, equals lies and hypocrisy. This is truth. If you can't accept or understand or believe this then you are as those who have built their houses upon sand...and the rains come.

Fourth, bringing your own baggage to prophecy. Usually this means you view a prophecy through some doctrine or other that you were taught in a church that you grew up in...or somebody said something that you remember and consciously or unconsciously "believe," though it really probably has nothing to do with anything. This is really common as most of the churches (ostensibly of God) have doctrines that require explanations and those explanations are frequently uh... intricate and require many leaps of...I shudder to say faith, but people place their faith in the hands of other people all the time; even though God says to "work out your own salvation with fear and trembling." True leaps of faith don't serve any persons financial end or attendance numbers and are likely to result in the

temporary death of the leaper as a martyr or similar less permanent reasons. Not because they crash during the leap but because they are men of God and their job is to be a sacrifice before the altar of God and face it...the best use of an old prophet (or young) is as a martyr...Of course, to not leap is to die perhaps eventually in this life and definitely forever in the next. But, if you can remember way up there where I started speaking about doctrine at the top of this paragraph...just note that I won't get started on doctrines here...that is an entirely different subject much like false prophecy, though related. Suffice it to say, leave your own baggage at home and ask the question words about everything and not from your perspective. If you have ANYTHING invested in the "outcome" of a prophecy...vou probably aren't objective enough to understand it...yet you must! To your shame. If you can't cast away your own stumbling blocks or know when to leap over them you will die. You aren't the point of any of this but you are individually and collectively the point of all of this. If this last bit distresses you...you obviously haven't read the "prophets" enough. Remember: "8 For all tables are full of vomit and filthiness, so that there is no place clean. 9 Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom shall he make to understand doctrine? [His WORD...not "christian living doctrine" or whatever] them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the breasts. 10 For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little: for with stammering lips and another tongue will he speak to this people. 12 To whom he said, This is the rest wherewith ye may cause the weary to rest; and this is the refreshing: yet they [you] would not hear. 13 But the word of the Lord was unto them precept upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little; that they might go, and fall backward, and be broken, and snared, and taken.' "15 Because ye have said, We have made a covenant with death, and with hell are we at agreement; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, it shall not come unto us: for we have made lies our refuge, and under falsehood have we hid ourselves: 16 Therefore thus saith the Lord God, Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious corner stone, a sure foundation: he that believeth shall not make haste. 17 Judgment also will I lay to the line, and righteousness to the plummet: and the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the [false] hiding place. 18 And your covenant with death shall be disannulled, and your agreement with hell shall not stand; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, then ye shall be trodden down by it. 19 From the time that it goeth forth it shall take you: for morning by morning shall it pass over, by day and by night: and it shall be a vexation only to understand the report. 20 For the bed is shorter than that a man can stretch himself on it: and the covering narrower than that he can wrap himself in it." Until you understand this passage completely and without question or doubt...you should be terrified. Being blind is terrifying.

Fifth, clinging blindly to false prophecy in the face of incontestable evidence to the contrary. Sigh! Hopefully anyone reading this far made it past the first questions and believes their Bible. This does not mean that you understand it. Just knowing that it contains the absolute truth is another beginning of understanding. You must then..."Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near:" because obviously there is a time when He will not be found, and a time in which your calls will not be heard. Have you never heard of "the famine of the hearing of the word???" "And when ye spread forth your hands, I will hide mine eyes from you: yea, when ye make many prayers, I will not hear: your hands are full of blood." "Thou hast covered thyself with a cloud, that our prayer should not pass through." "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee," Know then, that now, in this moment, God has turned His face away and listens with less than half an ear. If you think I lie about this or am mistaken...you are wrong and it would be best for you to deeply repent on bent knees...lest they be broken for you. "I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, That unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear. Surely, shall one say, in the Lord have I righteousness and strength: even to him shall men come; and all that are incensed against him shall

be ashamed." But He may still be found by those who earnestly seek Him and this is still a limited time offer. Once again, if you doubt the words I speak, it would be wise of you to keep it in your head and not open your mouth about it. For your words will be remembered and your blood is upon your own head.

You see, this is the part where you have to cast off the ludicrous idiocy of mainstream doctrines like the "rapture" as described by the "Left Behind" books and movies and who knows what other kind of merchandise and preached from who knows how many pulpits. I won't take the space to debunk it yet again here as even the most rudimentary study will disprove what is said about the "rapture" by the prophets of silky smooth words. This is definitively the scriptures mentioned above verses 8-20. If you have this sin and problem in your life then you must solve your own problem. Crack a Bible for crying out loud. Your blood is upon your own head and none of it will touch me.

Sixth, and probably the second most important factor, is that you must absolutely know the identity of the person/group of people the (any) prophecy is speaking to or about... Once again we are living in the last and latter days and the time of the late harvest and in the day of the lord's anger and in the time of the Revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ... All of the examples have been given in the Bible to navigate the end time. All of the prophecies that are absolutely necessary have been written (with notably few exceptions that nobody who reads this will know except by the spirit). The Word of the Lord has been given, sent, translated, and preached in one form or another to everyone worldwide and is available to everyone now, it is the Bible...the "open scroll." And yet the gospel has not been preached and our works are not complete. If you doubt this read Revelation 14:6. If you cannot comprehend why my prior statement is true from this passage then you need to seek God and read His book a whole lot more because there are dozens of clues around and in that scripture that indicate precisely when and where and how etc. The WHO is absolutely the most important thing when considering a prophecy from God. It tells you the history of their relationship and gives you a ton of clues as to the why et al...before you even ask these questions directly of the (written?) prophecy. I will assume written prophecy in general within my writings for the simple reason that prophecies coming out of the mouths of men at this time and in this place are highly suspect or by me at least, to be entirely disbelieved for a variety of reasons that I will not share with you at this time. Except, "my sheep hear my voice" and thus unless asleep or deaf/blind they will know who is speaking... "but the wise shall understand." If you don't like that...uh, too bad. You should already know why. If you don't...seek the Lord and ask and then listen to what He tells you through your Bible... "But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ve need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him. If you use this scripture to simply justify your own thoughts then you have run completely off the rails and your blood is upon your own head.

Seventh and another one that causes a lot of trouble with prophecy in the Bible is the variety of names and places and metaphors and concepts that are not readily understood in the Bible because of the length of time and changes in life style which render some metaphors incomprehensible or nearly so. Frequently God uses names that we do not know and may even be a bit lost to the biblical scholars out there from this time or before. Sometimes God refers to a particular group of people by the names of the places that they were taken into captivity at or He uses location names to refer to a people who took those lands from someone else and those names are not readily recognized as that particular group of people because the names were from the prior group, sometimes gentiles. This can be confusing and there is no easy way around it except knowing from reading and understanding a vast amount of other things from other scriptures and applying it appropriately. Nevertheless, any confusion about names can easily be removed by reading the clearer scriptures first as in most cases much of the material is repeated more than once. All that being said...God uses this and other things in the next point.

Eighth, God hides the prophecy and the meaning from you and others... Now why would God do that. We are the chosen ones aren't we??? Well, AREN'T we??? And here is the rub. The place where the problems really begin for a lot of people... God speaks to whom He wishes, when He wishes, in the manner He wishes, at the time He wishes. And nobody has the right to say BOO to Him about that or anything else. If that irritates you...no wonder you don't understand prophecy...you have no humility. Humility is an absolute requirement for being a prophet or simply understanding prophecy. Conversely, prophets do not appear to have ANY humility to those to whom they have been sent. They are seen only as arrogant donkeys with big mouths that inconveniently spray out truths that damage peoples lives and financial welfare. This is almost a law of prophecy and at this moment I can only think of one clear exception. This is because the people being prophesied to are disobeying God and will absolutely not have their noses rubbed in it by their own will and violence if necessary; Oh Jerusalem, you who kill the prophets. But it happens anyway because that is the prophets job. And if, those prophesied to, refuse to change, for an enormous variety of reasons, beginning with status quo, et al, ad infinitum then they get to die. Think Pharisees, Sadducees and anyone who is a hypocrite. <u>Usually</u> the prophets to these types have dealt with these problems in their lives prior to being sent...though, once again I can think of one exception. There is also a very exceptional circumstance for one prophet who was not so careful with either words or deeds, who was sent to a particular place at a particular time and this too was by God's will and for His purpose. A purpose that can only make sense in the end time, here, in this place and in this time, prior to the fall of Babylon. Look, seek and perhaps you shall find, I won't tell you the answer here. Most of God's prophecies are so deep with meaning that the surface is barely scratched by men and the various subtleties are very rarely understood completely. And hypocrites understand the least of all the prophecies. They get only the most shallow surface understanding and pretend it is deep, believing in their own depth, not knowing what depth truly is. Perhaps to people this shallow, it is deep. From my perspective...just deep enough to drown in. This is READILY apparent in the New Testament with Christ speaking in parables with thousands of people wandering around just to see signs and wonders...WOOOoooOOOO... and not there because of truth and reality. "Why speakest thou unto them in parables? He answered and said unto them, **Because it is given unto you to know** the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given. For whosoever hath, to him shall be given, and he shall have more abundance: but whosoever hath not, from him shall be taken away even that he hath. Therefore speak I to them in parables: because they seeing see not; and hearing they hear not, neither do they understand. And in them is fulfilled the prophecy of Esaias, which saith, By hearing ye shall hear, and shall not understand; and seeing ye shall see, and shall not perceive: For this people's heart is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes they have closed; lest at any time they should see with their eyes and hear with their ears, and should understand with their heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them. But blessed are your eyes, for they see: and your ears, for they hear. For verily I say unto you, <u>That many prophets and righteous men have</u> desired to see those things which ve see, and have not seen them; and to hear those things which ve hear, and have not heard them." This passage goes triple in this end time and tells the whole story without excess words about this and a number of other things. Understanding is not given to many, but a few. And those few should not cast their pearls before swine, thus parables. Perhaps I seem the hypocrite in this, as I am indeed casting some few pearls before some swine with the words you are reading. But the reality is that these pearls cannot be easily harmed by these swine. If indeed this word contains that pearl of Great Price...what self-respecting swine would trade in hiswill for putting his nose in a dry dusty old book? And what spirit would guide that swine to understanding while it slogs? Swine have little patience and much appetite. "but unto them that are without, all these things are done in parables: That seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be converted, and their sins should be forgiven them." God chooses whom He will, and forgives whose sins He will and He is no respecter of persons...He gives us

all a choice and we make it consciously or not. Son of God or not. Vessel of destruction or not. "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it." Live or die! The choice is very simple...the straight and narrow path leading to the straight and narrow gate is more complex but indeed simple and relies almost entirely on your attitude and the things you care about...that pearl of great price. "Let us search and try our ways, and turn again to the Lord."

Ninth, **most importantly** and touched on in the last section. The spirit of God. If you do not have the spirit of God in some capacity, these things are forever lost to you. Look, seek and perhaps you will find. If you "hath not" at this time and in this place... There is only one source of life; if you have not visited that deep well in earnest then it is pointless to pursue prophecy. Except to receive it and do that which seems good to you when it is force fed to you by a prophet of God...and there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Tenth, I read the King James Version. I suspect I always will unless God changes that. I use other versions and other study helps like Strongs; Youngs literal is helpful. I frequent expanded/ amplified versions/ translations also if I just can't get something, just because they usually include more of what the meaning linguistically or metaphorically could possibly be... but they can also introduce ideas that are incorrect. I know this when I come across it, usually after I have completely understood the passage by all of the things that are related to it. You can rarely know these things without God's spirit and a holistic view from far more than that specific verse. Deciding whether a translation is accurate or not is **not** something that most people will be able to do. But when it comes together in that way that you know the absolute truth of a thing, then you may be able to find a version of the Bible that expresses it more perfectly. I have not found this to be much use though. The understanding, yes, but I rarely skip around versions with people... Once again this is translation with stammering lips and another tongue...another language. It is supposed to be difficult or all of these Nods that are doing just whatever they want (that wicked and sexually immoral generation) could just say "the blood of Jesus Christ" before they died and enter the Kingdom. And then we would all be stuck with a bad case of cockroaches in the house of God. Thankfully God's ways are so much better than our ways...He has worked all this out completely. You should read all of Isaiah 55 now but I put a small part here. "Seek the Lord while He may be found, Call upon Him while He is near. Let the wicked forsake his way, And the unrighteous man his thoughts; Let him return to the Lord, And He will have mercy on him; And to our God, For He will abundantly pardon. "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways," says the Lord. "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts."

Eleventh, The big picture...it is my experience that nobody gets the big picture. I have never met or heard anyone that truly gets the big picture. People have lots of distorted little pictures on various puzzle pieces and they are frequently jammed together incorrectly like a toddler with glue, a mallet and a 2500 piece puzzle. **But what good is it to tell a blind man** (in a crowd of men, blind from birth, who are holding on to a string of other blind and apparently deaf men, whose blind and blindered leaders are yelling "LOOK, isn't it marvelous,") **that you can see?**

Of course, you can always shine a light in their eyes and see who reacts...

Some will just be asleep... and not want to wake...

Some will react positively... and might make enough effort to live.

Many more will react negatively... and eat drink and be merry for tomorrow they die.

Some will attack like zombies... because they *like* having all those people in captivity to or with

If you can truly <u>see</u> it is amazingly easy to know how much someone else can see. Usually painfully easy. They are concerned about the wrong things. They talk about the wrong things and this is unbelievably obvious when the white elephant and the 800lb gorilla are in the same room and nobody comments on them... Christ dodged lots and lots of blind zombies. In the end they got Him because He <u>chose</u> that method to get rid of them (demons too)...it served <u>His</u> purpose. If you don't like that...you have a choice. And by now you should know what that is...

Twelfth, Ah...the subject of truth and whose truth is whose. There are many many things to be said about truth. This section is about personal truth and how to recognize it and know whether it has been manipulated. If you see clearly, this and a variety of other things will give you x-ray vision about lies and truth and hypocrisy.

It is positively amazing that God can hide so many distinctly personal messages within so many, many generalities within His Book. I have to laugh at the cheekiness of Peter (though he may not have understood precisely all the little pieces of what he was saving...nevertheless totally true) when he says "that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation." this makes me laugh because it is so true but also this passage is so desperately easily and consistently misinterpreted by anyone willing to do so; and almost always by hypocrites. It is a fallback scripture to attempt to win an argument when all else has failed or at least, that is when I have heard it most used. The scripture is *completely true* in that no prophecy of God will be hidden away beyond a certain point and that it is ALL directly related to God and His will and doesn't serve the interests of anyone else in righteousness. As it is most often used incorrectly, it is an accusation of lying and false prophecy. If prophetic scripture does serve someone else' ends...it is either simple coincidence in the moment or it is being misused or both; and there is likely a hypocrite and sheep thief very near. It does **not** mean that there aren't any personal messages, insights and/or understandings that are given (perhaps solely in a given time) to individuals either about themselves or of others in righteousness. Really, how obvious is that??? Five people can read the same passage and get 5 different correct things out of it. Conversely, some people can't get anything correct out of the Bible at all, go figure...they are missing another component required for truth. People get the depth of meaning out of the scriptures depending on the Spirit of God and how much they have invested themselves in the treasures of God. To whom does God reveal things? And how does He reveal things? Really...it's a no brainer. The wise shall understand. But it is rare for a thing to be revealed through more than one person at the same time...it happens but not often in this time. And what person, given insight directly into a thing of God, by God...immediately perverts it? Not the person whom God stirred His spirit in and caused them to understand! Usually it's a thief in the temple of God hearing it secondhand and stealing His words one from another as the scripture says... A moneychanger, sheep thief, etc. they are all the same, looking for a smooth road for themselves which usually means money or power over other people. Usually corruption of understanding happens when people learn the truth of God and are corrupted over time and turn into hypocrites; a gradual process in most. Once a hypocrite, almost anything could be fair game to be manipulated or not depending upon how large is the branch of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil they are sitting under. They will keep some of the things of God correctly, if insincerely (though they believe otherwise...it's just convenient for them to be righteous in their own eyes) and others they will abandon and justify by hook or more probably crook. It isn't usually a conscious decision at the beginning and mostly takes time for them to fester their bad attitudes about something and then adjust things to their liking, claiming revelation or new understanding or blah, blah long explanations to circumvent the truth. *This* is the definition of a personal interpretation...when someone twists the word of truth to their use and for their purposes to gain power or money. Not simply stating the truth for God's own sake. The convenience and inconvenience of truth and the internal corruption of attitude and spirit creates

hypocrites. Their willingness to exploit what is conveniently true for them and ignore or dispose of that which is inconvenient and painful to them. As spoken from God, truth is simply or in complexity... TRUTH. Whether only one person is given the understanding or 10 million is moot. This whole subject of the purity of truth and will is one that God is absolutely clear about. And which <u>is</u> at the very core, <u>shiny, bright and clean in every true prophet.</u> And which is <u>utterly corrupt</u> in every manipulator of God's word...devil quoting scripture...etc. It's also the reason why there are so very few true prophets. A prophet must absolutely understand and maintain the clarity and purity of Truth! As well as God's will and His intent behind that truth. This is what creates purity of sight and clarity of vision and is that which allows a prophet to understand and act upon or teach the word of truth. Most people put some kind of spin on things that focuses varying degrees of attention on them for personal aggrandizement...pride or greed or whatever makes them or their idol, the corrupt vomitous messes that God will absolutely <u>burn</u> before His Kingdom comes. God MUST be the center of everything we do in <u>truth</u> or we will eventually or immediately perish.

Thirteenth, and companion to the section above... "But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in *Christ.* "Ah this is also a huge scripture for all that pull the wool over the eyes of God's sheep. It is as always with Bible scriptures...absolutely true. But it is very, very easily used by devils quoting scripture. It is perhaps the best pacifier and turner of grown men into babies that there is! It is used upon those that don't understand something in the Bible and the **sheepthief** who is their "minister" either doesn't know the answer or doesn't like whatever question or doctrine or answer the sheep brings them from outside the sheepthiefs corral. This is, of course, a direct misleading of the sheep in that the sheep receives no answer and is sent home hungry because the sheepthief did not feed them the correct answer or even dig deeper into the question...for it is a spiritual question...and how could he, not having the spirit of God? Or, having spoken without the spirit, just wants the problem to go away without panicking any other sheep. "The prophets prophesy falsely, and the priests bear rule by their means; and my people love to have it so: and what will ye do in the end thereof?" The shockingly amazing thing is how well sheep LOVE to eat this up! It's like crack for lambs and for good reason. It feeds the vanity of the soul...and confirms the absolute correctness of the cramped, closed-minded worldview that hears it. Such a one can only conclude it must be true...because..."who is more complex or more intelligent than I???" Having heard that everything within these two brain cells is perfect...and that their judgment is supreme in complex intelligence...there is nothing left to do but continue slumbering the sleep which leads to death.

Reality is that there are several flaws in logic and the sheep's ability to address these flaws that make it a really fantastic pacifier. I have always been astonished at its effectiveness.

- 1. Most sheep aren't terribly intelligent...through lack of effort more than anything...they forget or don't apply "wise as serpents harmless as doves." When a sheep runs up against something that may or may not be true, the reaction is usually to bleat loudly and hope whatever is bothering them goes away. If someone says "simplicity in Christ" their confusion at whatever it was immediately goes away because...as EVERYONE knows Christ is SIMPLE. Skip to the next point.
- 2. Christ is NOT SIMPLE *or simple-minded*, those handing out pacifiers know this but would like you to believe this. The sheep also know this but are almost always willing to be pacified. Anyone with two brain cells to rub together knows that God who created the whole earth and everything in it and the rest of the galaxies and super galaxies and the whole universe is not simple. But it is an easy way to pacify someone by appealing to their monumental pride and bringing anything more complex than the two brain cells of that sheep down to the same size as that sheep and comfort them into falsely believing that they are complex and nothing is bigger

- than them. They stop bleating and their brow unwrinkles in relief. I understate it <u>pan-galactically</u> when I say that this leaves the sheep in a prideful circumstance that makes it a little difficult to understand the scope of God's plan...
- 3. This is not to say that there are no simple concepts or clear doctrines or things that may be understood by even those of less than average intellect. For there is much simplicity in Christ. In the Bible this is usually called the milk of the word. And it is good and people of less complexity can easily understand these things. They can also be confused by a lot of things. Hold fast that which you KNOW is truth. *Do NOT hold fast to sheepthieves!* Hold fast to the word of God. Sheepthieves want to keep you *stupid happy* so you don't bother them and keep paying tithes and offerings to them only. Oh and put all your property in their name when you die. This is the simplicity behind the pacifier.
- 4. There is also complexity in Christ! There are many, many things of dramatic complexity in both the physical world and also in the parts of the spiritual world that we have access to...the Bible, doctrines, prophecies, etc. We have no idea about the parts of God that He has not shown us. But based upon the complexity of the plan that we are currently part of I can tell you in absolute truth that this "short work upon the earth" is not God's idea of rocket science. It is a prelude to many greater things. Believe this in faith...or not.
- 5. Let's face it...sheep aren't very good at confrontation and making choices. If you know anything about sheep. You know that they would rather do anything than confront a shepherd...whether false or true. They may hear their Master's voice but they do NOT want to confront Him or anyone else. They would rather choose ANY escape route...especially the closest one. Sheep need to learn to confront this inability and make it an ability. For if they do not confront their captors? How can the truth set them free? And also...who will work in the harvest? I do not say...be rebellious! But simply speak the truth in righteousness in the moment it matters. There is much more to say about this at some other time.
- 6. The definition of the actual word "simplicity" is completely ignored because who really needs the Greek or Hebrew anyway. With only two brain cells to rub together; other languages waste precious space. As you can see below, "singleness" is the best translation but it flows uncomfortably in English so they used simplicity...truly giving the impression of the simplicity in the most basic milky truths, but falsely giving the connotation of lacking complexity. Perhaps the best single word that I can come up with besides singleness is straightforwardness. I do not say that simplicity is wrongly translated...I think it is great and probably inspired directly by God. A great filter to strain out hypocrites and keeping the cockroaches out of His Kingdom. Stammering lips and another tongue after all.

Fourteenth, reactions to truth: this will have to wait for another time, as it isn't yet...

Fifteenth, flak from the people and attitudes around you...including your own. Don't underestimate this one. This is probably the biggest hurdle most of you will encounter if you try to wake up and understand prophecy and actually attempt to get into God's Kingdom. This is a serious MAJOR problem. Your enemies will be those of your own household and the people around you in

your life (or death if you do nothing). I have hit this enough in other places but know that our birth into the kingdom of God is not without some pain and blood. The Pharisees are ever with us and they will try to kill you with words and reduce your faith to nothing and you will have to break their hold on you or you will die. This is no small thing. As I write this I am fighting some of these battles and I know how easily others lack of faith can take the wind out of your sails...if you let it! I won't let it and because of that, it strengthens me more than it discourages. God's mercy is great indeed but mercy where mercy is due. He knows what both the right and the left hand are doing. Always. Refer back to this paragraph later as this next bit goes off to the side a bit only to circle back around.

Remember that the blind **don't** get into the Kingdom, they fall in the ditch. Uh...that means "lake of fire" if you translate the parable. Yep, the really HOT place that you get tortured forever for being like "Ye blind guides, which strain at a gnat, and swallow a camel. Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye make clean the outside of the cup and of the platter, but within they are full of extortion and excess. Ye serpents, ye generation of vipers, how can ve escape the damnation of hell?" Oh and there are more than plenty of scriptures like that one. Thus...if you are blind you are dead forever...and you can't understand prophecy...or at least not enough to keep from grabbing something you shouldn't in a dark alley or tripping on a stumbling block in bright sunlight. But if you can see and are not blind then you can understand prophecy and know what the future holds and ding, ding, ding, you may enter the Kingdom of God if you work out your own salvation with fear and trembling and abject humility knowing the love and grace of God. There are, of course, people who will enter the Kingdom without understanding prophecy. This is wonderful, fantastic and generous of God. There are however some drawbacks which I will not go through here, except to note, that if you are of the Body of Christ...or the Temple of God or even the outer court...you will either qualify at a high level in the Kingdom...or you won't be there at all. And...if you think you were grafted in and don't have any responsibility and can just slide on down through a loophole...uh no! That isn't how it works. Just go look at any tree with grafts in it...it is part of the tree and nobody would mistake it for anything but part of the tree and everything else are details. Grafting just takes you from a dying tree to a better living tree...if you decide not to grow into part of that tree then as the scripture says you will be cut off. To him that has will be given more, to him that doesn't try or tries to coast in...even what he has will be taken from him and given to another. Pearl of Great Price...or what is it they say in poker... ALL IN! No hedging your bets...no bunting...fence sitting...it's all or nothin' baby. I'm sure you can think of a few of your own phrases.

But that paragraph was all just a lead-in to the actual part that is going to make your life a living hell and guarantee that you are not only ALL IN but that if you have any of the actual love of God (or fear!) within you, you will actually be able to SEE (as in, not being blind and dead). But before we actually get to that you must answer another question...write it down below.

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Shucks, don't you wish this was an online test that you could get instant feedback on your score. As it isn't, you can't. Unless, of course, you ask me yourself. Let me tell you that your answer... whatever you wrote on the blank above is almost surely wrong. I do believe that it is possible that someone, somewhere, could potentially get it right, but I don't really believe it will happen without hearing it from me prior or by the spirit of God probably in the moment. If you say wow...this guy is an arrogant ass...hmmm maybe you should carefully consider the size on the tag of your britches. I do not speak without care nor am I interested in magnifying myself to be greater than anyone else. If you are still reading this, it is *likely* that you are my brethren. And that is a good thing. But I <u>can</u> see what you cannot in this moment; and as noted before, it's pretty obvious and easy in most circumstances to know

a blind man from a seeing man. And I can "see" many of the things that people would or will write in blindness and death or the partial, self interested, sleep paralyzed, nearly closed lidded, peripheral vision which is the best I have ever seen in even the most exceptionally awake people that I have ever heard, heard of, met or known. I myself have been at best, partially awake and it is only in the last few years that I have begun to clearly understand the whole BIG PICTURE. Thus, when I tell you that your answer is wrong...I have a more than fair certainty of being correct. Because I do know what is next and the thing after that, and the thing after that. And I do know how it will affect you and the people and attitudes around you. And I can say with absolute certainty that it will happen HERE in America... soon. Behold it knocks...it is at the very doors...it calls for you and you WILL make a choice whether you like it or not. Because it is not in your power to prevent that choice being made obvious to you if you have not clearly chosen that good thing prior to the time of your visitation. And the people around you will make a choice whether they like it or not. In fact, the choice has already been made... And it is not in their power to prevent that choice being made obvious to them if they have not clearly chosen a better outcome prior to the time of visitation. By not actually choosing prior in faith and deed and <u>fact</u>, you have made the choice and it will be revealed to you whether you believe it or not. And because you are reading this, your enemies will be they in your own household. Family member against family member. Sheep against sheep and sheep against wolf. Wheat against tare. Hypocrite against believer, church goer against church goer. And every conceivable combination of all of the above. Except the hypocrites will generally agree with each other that they should cast out or destroy anyone speaking words like these and will be very reasonable and tolerant and pacific until it's really obvious that that just won't work; just exactly as their fathers in the time of the Sacrifice of our Messiah. For I am not come to bring peace but division! As my Lord and Master before me. It is enough that the servant be as his master.

In the military and with tough country boys everywhere there is the saying "God, family, country..." It's kind of an "American" thing to say but let's face it; that saying is just idealized BS. Like a parable...true on the surface but unlike a parable the deeper meaning is corrupted. The fact is, that we give attention to the things around us that most immediately require our attention. The cares of the world surround us and hedge us in and are a stumbling block. Your wife screaming at you that you need to do this or that or the other thing...demands that we do that thing asked of us by the person or thing in front of us rather than the actual needful thing; which is to obey God and let the dead bury their dead. There is **one** pearl of Great price. Family and country don't get a seat on the train unless your family are all individually, intentionally riding to the same place. "He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me. He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it." "And the brother shall deliver up the brother to **death**, and the father the child: and the children shall rise up against their parents, and cause them to be put to death. And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved." Do you understand completely the truth of these words? Do you know when these things shall be? I will tell you that it is now and soon to grow into that which so few understand and nearly subconsciously fear, and rightly so. How is that for a small sample of sight? Of, being able to see. From experience, I know that even with this that I have written, you have missed the majority of the depth of the meaning above. Most people will not even look into the valley of the shadow of death, much less enter the path; for this is the strait and narrow...they will do anything not to face the reality of the choice that is ever before them. They will do anything to protect their family and their way of life with their things and money. And they will ever give these things attention and precedence over God. He is just an inconvenience in most peoples lives, the best they can do is pay lip service and lie and steal and cheat and do all the things that God tells us not to. And, it is easy to see that most of these blind ones have not even really CONSIDERED putting any money down on that pearl of great price. You see the cost is quite simply, too high for most people. Go and sell all that you own and come and

follow me! Yeah right!!! Leave my wife and family? Are you just beginning to have a vague notion of the faint glimmering of sight? Maybe not...as you have probably been hearing that scripture all your life and it's just a phrase that you have grown to ignore as nobody has done it for real (or it went fully awry if they did) or asked it of you or anyone else...well...except of course, God. [Be aware that this thing is a thing asked in a particular time for a particular time at Gods will. You are not righteous just because you leave your wife or life...the opposite is more probable if you do these things on your own without God.] Things like this...both the scripture and the choice...make people want to close their eyes and never open them again...and that is A choice. A bad choice given our current circumstance. The crows and the ravens sit on the fence. They wait for blood. Blissfully ignorant; not knowing it is their own; and that they will be burned in the fire by men, as chaff from the harvest. There are those who are partially paying attention and will be faithful but they are the exception, not the rule. It is to these people that I say Love your family enough to follow God and do your best to teach them and persuade them and convince them to come with you, following God, in the time that is left or they will die. Dying with them will not save them but they have some chance if you cleanse yourself and follow God! "and I will take you one of a city, and two of a family," "Be ye therefore ready also: for the **Son of man** cometh at an hour when ve think not." This last is no joke and is no metaphor and there is much more to this that I won't tell you...but **KNOW** it's seriousness. Search the scripture and find God and what He wants!!!

And if a lot of that above wasn't just a giant sackful of metaphors...but you get my various points. Christianity is about to take a turn for the better and be purified by fire of all the impurities and all of the everyday "christian living" and social clubs and/or whatever garbage the moneychangers in the temple have sold you that is not actually even remotely dedicated to God and which starves you of anything that could nourish you before God. If you don't believe this...fine. Sit on the fence but I promise you before God and man, Heaven and earth that this will happen in your days (except you be old and feeble and ready to die and still it comes quickly and may overtake you) and to your family and to your congregation and to your town, and to your city and to your state and at the last to your foster country; in truth your captors. I speak the truth, I do not lie and my words will not fall to the ground. Heed them or die. Who knows...maybe someone near you will listen, take it seriously and all of your family and friends might not die the worst deaths that anyone including me, can imagine. "And whosoever shall not receive you, **nor hear you**, when ye depart thence, shake off the dust under your feet for a testimony against them. Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrha in the day of judgment, than for that city." If you do nothing, your people have no hope at all, but then again maybe they never did...those around you and you yourself may just be chaff. Either way, you can't control it. Who lives or dies isn't up to you and never was, except as to your choice prior to the visitation of the son of man and your good (or bad) influence on the people around you. God will choose whom He will choose and you can only trust His perfect judgment to bring you and everyone you love to the best conclusion. Facing reality and only flinching but choosing to fear and love your God and moving on is the only way to do it. Turn your heart to God and never look away or you and your people are lost. Face the valley of the shadow of death and give up YOUR own life and you may just find it. Try to save it and you will be one of those ten thousand on a man of Gods right...or the thousand on the other side. You choose. Or someone will cement your semi-unconscious choice for you to your everlasting sorrow when you least expect it.

"And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel's, But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life." I could prove to you the truth of all of this biblically, but these are pearls that swine could eat and thus...

Sixteenth, and way, way up there on the importance list, is to take a big step back from the individual verses in the Bible and just ponder for a moment the works that God has done. From Adam and Eve and instruction and then disobedience and kicked out of Eden and curses and then Cain and Abel and murder and punishment...the flow of history through the old testament and Noah, and disobedience so much that God just decided to drown the roaches and there were only 8 people left on the ark and then the tower of Babel, isn't that the confusion that tried to rise up to heaven? And to righteous Abraham and a chosen people selected and Lot and of course Sodom and Gomorrah (a people DE-SELECTED) and then Israel in Egypt and Moses the prophet and instruction and the punishment of Pharoah...disobedient to God and responsible to the person Moses... and then on the way out of Egypt with lots of stuff...and Pharoah disobedient again and well dead...pillars of fire and out of Egypt and disobedience followed quickly by the Ten commandments crushing the disobedience and 10 more commandments...well another copy burned into stone by the finger of GOD anyway. And a tent as the house of God. Then lots of walking and complaining and disobedience and whining and quail of all things and sickness and then lots and lots more walking and death and prophets and priests and a renaissance of good attitudes and punishment of Moses mistake and then the Promised Land (which suddenly and mysteriously seems like a metaphor for the Kingdom of God hunh) that God gave and peace and the wonder of Gods ways David and Jerusalem and Solomon...the Temple of the Living God! Then sin and prophets and prophecies and the anger of God unleashed a bit, and the temple destroyed and most of God's people dead and a remnant in captivity in a far country called Babylon and that tower thingy is gone now though and upon whom is laid responsibility for the blood of all of God's people in all ages who have died and then prophets and prophecies and a return and reconciliation and rebuilding the Temple of the Living God! And the Old Testament fully written and then disobedience, Pharisees and hypocrites and JESUS CHRIST THE LORD OUR GOD and disciples and instruction and prophecy and miracles and prophecy and wonders and prophecy and instruction and disobedience and crucifixion and the veil rent and destroy this temple and in 3 days I will raise it up and BLOOD and DEATH and RESURRECTION and Apostles and instruction and death and disobedience and death and the New Testament written and sudden destruction of what was left of the Temple of God after He left it and the children of Israel carried into far away countries in a thing called the Dispersion or Diaspora where 12 whole tribes were lost and they were enslaved and they lost their identities mostly and the Jews kinda lost their identities but kinda remade them but got infiltrated by a whole buncha people who weren't and got all uppity and wouldn't believe because they were the sons of disbelievers because everything they had been taught to expect took longer and didn't happen the way they thought it should and they just weren't happy and for everybody a slow and miserable watering down and changing of most everything God ever said or was ever written and these people inspired by those annoying demon types who just thought a few improvements to their benefit would be nice and the Catholics were instrumental here as was the council of Nicaea and Hillel the IInd or Turd I can't remember and some miserable garbage called the Kaballah and all this during the interregnum prophesied by Christ after He planted the field for the latter harvest and said the enemy would sow weeds and then the WORD of GOD codified into the BIBLE and a renaissance of interest in God spurred on by technology like the printing press and people learning how to read and then philosophers pooh pooh the Bible and create more interest in a new god called SCIENCE and this is great fertilizer for weeds and Hunh world war invented and nuclear bombs and Nazi's and all that stuff way back there in Revelation starts to make a little more sense and What??? Judah re-inherits most of the promised land and it isn't the Kingdom of God but old prophecies are dusted off for a while and then nobody can figure out anything else over there so they try tolerance and getting along with everybody more or less when they aren't killing anybody that messes with them cuz they are pissed and confused about this pretty gigantic punishment by God but it was really a blessing in disguise? and it got them a country and back into inheritance with God and disobedience and a wicked and adulterous generation and I looked and there was no man... who really followed God and there wasn't either...at all and a bunch of

churches were started by people that were genuinely interested in God in a place called America and there was no man there either...yet America has a shockingly and astoundingly complete resemblance to that place called Babylon or confusion or whatever it was and just look at the way they tower up to the heavens trying to build and destroy and look at the way that nasty bitch beats all those different countries with that whip and now she's feeding them some wine in a cup and they are mesmerized and that thing is Beastly and these people in the churches act just exactly like the Israelites and behave identically and have all the characteristics of those lost 12 tribes...their faces even look the same and funny thing nobody else anywhere in the world is really interested in the things that those people are interested in and shucks...they almost all came to Confusion uh sorry America for freedom of religion and they seem to think that they are grafted in which is weird and sounds interesting but makes no sense because if they are all grafted in...what and where is what they are grafted into...oh...look I think they think they are grafted into themselves and that guy just said go xxxx yourself...Ha Ha Ha...wow they truly are sons of they who killed the prophets and why is God so mad again and Oh yeah they were supposedly were grafted into the Body of Christ and that is of course the Temple of the Living God and wow we are back to that temple thingy again and not one stone upon another and why do all the scriptures make perfect sense in the end time and also as a historic record? Hunh...that IS a real puzzler...except that God fella is sharper than a sack of wet mice and He must have figured out how to make it true then AND now...well that makes sense...specially cuz history repeats itself over and over again any nod brained nitwit knows that, and yep those people have no clue nope not that they are the lost tribes and why are there 6 million jews in Confusion...uh...America and 6 million in Israel and boyoh-boy those churches in Confusion really, really quickly fell to greed and science and greed and disobedience and false prophecy and blindness and more sin and greed and of course hypocrisy and Pharisees and more hypocrisy and well blindness and man you would think they could see something...they appear to be waiting for something they call the "rapture" that is so obviously not what they think...that's just ridiculous...I'm not even entirely sure they can read...whatever is this whole business about the Day of the Lords Anger and The Revelation of Jesus Christ and is that guy who's all alone down there really messing with a stage like this is going to be a play and then God comes back at the end? And is God really pissed again about the same stuff and Oh yeah...He always gets pissed about the same stupidity every time because those idiots keep doing the same stupid thing over and over and why are they worshiping trees and bowing down to strange idols and stones and this technology god and themselves...they really like to make things and buy things and worship them...that technology guy has really taken on some converts and they have done this so many times since this started I am going to puke if I have to see another tree with that shiny glittery crap on it. And disobedience and sin and yep He's definitely pissed again and I'm kinda surprised the whole place doesn't just melt...really that happens later...cool and didn't someone somewhere say that all this day of the Lord's anger business is going to fall on one single generation and that generation is sexually perverse and it was better that these people be born in Sodom and Gomorrah than here cuz they died faster back then because God rained down burning sulfur on them because of their abominations? Yep...I can confirm that...I was actually at that city of Sodom location and I have held the round sulfur balls in my hand and they light and burn easily... O Man o man this is getting good cuz He's really pissed and this is going to go like fireworks once a real prophet is raised in this place...He said He would do it...hey there's that Zerubbabel cat ...oh no...I think that guy just kinda looks and acts like him and wasn't he prophesied to start building another Temple by Ezekiel or something and yep...not one stone left upon another...wow these things just keep going around like a ball on a string and doesn't Zerubbabel mean born in Confusion...sorry Babylon and look He's feeding the flock of the slaughter...yep they're going to get slaughtered you can see it coming... and He's got that line in his hand and the skinny ones are going that way and OHHh he's eating the fat ones...just cutting them up and chowing down...exactly why are all those blind people walking off that cliff when they just need to open their eyes and wow...some of those people wake up really grumpy some just say xxxx it and close their eyes but they don't die

immediately when they fall off the cliff it sort of rounds off and they roll and break bones and stuff and wow those people are hungry and I feel more than a little sick...swallow...that woman just boiled her child and ate it with a knife and fork and *heave* that guy just killed his father and is chewing on him and that guy just took a bite out of his own arm and oh I am so glad those FIERCE guys from the north are killing them all now and I absolutely must get that out of my head and oooh...they are hauling all those people off as slaves...must be they are shaved bald on no, that was just the radiation and they are naked...and ewwghk...I don't think I would like to be treated that way for 42 months, obviously the outer court of the Temple of God and maybe they will get back to Jerusalem from the 4 winds when that is done and OooohhHHH! Hail fire and blood and all the grass burnt up... look some of them did leave just before all 5 parts of Confusion was destroyed by that stone like Daniel said...Duh they should have left without haste like they were clearly told many different times and why are those few thinking about going that way when they could just go back to Jerusalem and inherit in their own place. GOD is still SOOOOO ANGRY...but not at those remnant people now that He threw that last little batch back into the fire on that island and let's face it nobody has ever been that pissed and why do you think that was...Ohhh sorry I'm a little dense this has played out the same exact way over and over again with the prophet and instruction and disobedience and punishment and how can anybody be that stupid and not understand who they are???? yeah maybe their parents didn't tell them who they are...but borrow a mirror or something, or look in the open scroll, anything is way better than eating your own arm or kid or father and I think I am going to be sick again and this thing has repeated so many times that I got lulled into sleep...what time is it I'm tired...yawn...those hypocrite folks didn't do so well...killed a few of the good guys but they got hammered...neither did those money changer people back in the day that He kicked out of the Temple before they killed Him...and He sure had His revenge though when He sent that watchman guy with the laser...he's slaying those preacher/moneychanger guys like nobody's business...they don't seem to know it yet but he knocked over all their chess pieces and yes they do keep coming back like cockroaches but it doesn't matter they're dead and will realize it shortly when that cool rock hits the feet with the iron and miry clay...those people are boiling their own child for dinner is that even possible for a human to do??...no hey wait that was the same guy we saw on ty the other day that televangelist dude and ehh who really cares about him anyway...ate his own kid...deserves whatever he gets and anyway they were snacking on all those people in their church too, a little slower but they were being slowly starved and eaten too and that's just gross...those people actually have bite marks on them...they look pretty skinny like they haven't eaten in a while...what is that nasty garbage they feed them in all those church places. I would HATE to have to eat that. Most disgusting food I have ever seen. Has nobody ever heard of meat in due season? This is tiring...I have to get some sleep maybe some day we can go over what happens next...

"The hands of the pitiful women have sodden [boiled] their own children: they were their meat in the destruction of the daughter of my people."

Seventeenth, So another one of those things that kind of sails right on by everyone... <u>Which is</u> <u>the true church of God?</u> There are after all, thousands of churches out there <u>religiously collecting</u> <u>tithes and passing the basket and binding heavy burdens upon skinny starving sheep</u>. But apparently everybody has to choose which church to attend. And, everyone, eventually, kinda, makes a choice and becomes an ABC Protestant or a whatever, whatever... People do this based upon the <u>worst possible</u> <u>criteria</u>. They do it based upon flavor...just like going to an ice cream store and choosing a flavor based upon <u>personal choice</u> in doctrines or individual social standing/connections and family ties. People choose what is most comfortable to them and by what <u>they</u> believe, thus usually <u>reinforcing their own lack of understanding</u>. This is the epitome of poor choices. It is right out from under the tree of the knowledge of good and evil and will result in death. The only people likely to do well from this kind of interaction are the skinny of the flock that get in trouble with church management for questioning

doctrines and trying to understand things that have already been "decided!" doctrinally in that sect and thus these people are usually segregated, starved and eventually vanish from the flock for several reasons. The ones most successful with God, end up having church at home and forsaking the thieves and sheep merchants. Many are lost and die because of all the various predators but the ones that actually do, really, truly believe in God typically move on and continue skeptically and mistrustfully of men trying to find Him. This is true GOLD. Because these people who are shoved aside and mistreated and bullied are among the few that are at all likely to actually truly find God. Though not without much trial and error, pain and suffering. These things are all very necessary for humility. Eventually, they come to the realization that the sheep merchants cannot and will not feed them and then they are actually set up to find the one true God. If they don't fall into some of the other traps that must be navigated when sheep run around alone or in very small groups in the wilderness. It is to these, that my words are much more likely to be found and eaten, for these know the value of clean food and water that has not been pissed in by those that nudge with the shoulder and push with their horns. Ah! For good food that doesn't desire or require their blood and death to feed one who is not their Master. His sheep hear His voice! Though they may be a little dismayed when they eat it and it is sweet as honey to the tongue but gives them a little indigestion. Better a belly ache than death and hell. These people have been around the block and been chased back and forth so they are skittish, mistrustful, and are unlikely to listen to anybody without a really hard listen. They also tend to know a scripture or two in the Bible which makes them a bit easier to speak to as they have some understanding themselves, though perhaps more than normal loads of baggage. It is these people that I am really here for and to help save. It is these that need feeding and strengthening for the times to come. There is a limit to how much I can help these people though, so I would recommend that anyone that feels a little skinny, eat and drink in, as much as you can, without price and give to those around you to eat and strengthen that which may be strengthened as time is short and when the time comes the halt and lame and lost and those unable to feed on their own are going to die. It is no consolation but the lives of these people will be held to the account of the fat false shepherds who steal the Lords sheep and their guilt will make them pay in the day of their judgment which will come sooner rather than later. These are they who have lied and spoken soft things, pleasant things that have led people astray and into stagnancy and blindness and death. They will die for it, but others with more or less innocent blood will pay the price. These sheep should be perilously aware of the price of captivity for this is the faith and patience of the saints... "He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity. "And anyone riding herd on God's sheep without His express direction is likely to be skinned, declawed, dehorned, their teeth broken and sent to the slaughterhouse be they fat sheep, wolf or shepherd who says "Lord have we not..."

There is after all...only one temple of God, body of Christ, church of God etc. Or, 7 at most...in this time. That doesn't mean that those 7 are in any way safe from the true shepherd of God if they have been misbehaving. This leads us into the next point which is where lots of peoples eyebrows will rise a bit more.

Eighteenth, So what work is God actually going to do here in America prior to the fall of Bablylon? And that, **is** the trillion dollar question which I didn't answer above. Frankly, I won't tell you all that much about it. I know what will happen in some detail and I'm not particularly interested in talking about a lot of it in more than very general terms. *The great falling away* is broadly what is actually going to occur. There are many other things prophetic but this is the broad stroke. You will have to observe the mechanics of how that happens yourselves. It's all there in your bible but it will require a vast amount of understanding to be able to see the details. There will be a lot of important things happening but they will be mostly discounted until America is actually falling. "the day of thy watchmen and thy visitation cometh; now shall be their perplexity."

Nineteenth, "And you shall know that I am the Lord God." This is, perhaps, one of the most

useful thread studies that can be done in the Bible...in my opinion. If you need humility? Here it is. If you need to understand why God does most of the things that He does...Here it is. Read 'em and weep. Oh, you thought I was going to list all of them out and do the study for you. Nope, do it yourselves. There are many variations of the phrase but if you search by "know that I am" in quotes that will give you 83ish of them. Probably one of the most common phrases in the Bible and always has the same basic setting and connotations. If you *cannot* understand just a little bit of who God is and what He is trying to accomplish from these words and the context...pack it in...you are deaf, blind, dumb and mute. Nothing I say will help you, ever. That which dies let it die.

Twentieth, If anyone in this place and this time, prior to the fall, EVER tells you that this or that was "fulfilled..." Or, uses the phrase "already fulfilled." Know within yourself that this person is blind beyond guestion or doubt and has created or believed a lie and has no authority from God to do anything beyond themselves! Indeed they are fighting a great battle with and against themselves and except they quickly shed this snakeskin they will not stand. This is almost always accompanied by the false "rapture" doctrine. I could give you a thousand examples of why this "fulfilled" thing is a lie but that is a waste of my time. I have told you. Suffice it to say that if you believe this and use this as a lens through which to see prophecy...your glasses will not be merely rose colored but utterly darkened that you positively *cannot see* the everlasting hell which approaches you and is, indeed, right behind you...as you face the wrong direction in battle. Not that looking back will help you at this point. There are many things in prophecy and scripture and rarely are those things "fulfilled" never to be filled full again but yes...there will come a time rather sooner than later but that is not now. There were and are 5 Babylons and the people of God have been involved one way or another in all of them. And will be until that great mountain is thrown into the sea. It is a back and forth and back and forth and back and forth that continues until the Revelation is complete and Babylon is brought back into remembrance before God one final time.

"And in her was found the blood of prophets, and of saints, and of <u>all</u> that were slain upon the earth. And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God: <u>For true and righteous are his judgments</u>: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand. And again they said, Alleluia And her smoke rose up for ever and ever."

Saying it is "fulfilled" as if something cannot happen again in this time and place is simple-minded foolishness that was made-up so that someone could sell you a bridge and tell you something pleasant that you wanted to hear. And you wanted to hear it... "and my people love to have it so." That thing usually has to do with the midst of the week or such like so a blind shepherd who continually robs the temple of God could pretend and seem to know something which is really nothing because it has been corrupted by ignorance, foolishness and money. Besides they never get whatever scripture they sell in deception completely correct anyway. These things claimed and sold by the sheepmerchants and anything like them which are said or claimed around "fulfilled" is unequivocally blindness and death. Buy and eat this poison at your peril for the cost to buy it from a sheep merchant is far less than the price you will pay in hell for believing such a stupid lie. And, once again, you MUST BELIEVE what all prophecy says. If you don't know how or when or why because they have not of a truth been revealed to you, then hold your tongue, not repeating hell and damnation for yourself and others. But, if you fail to believe that God is true and the words He has spoken are true and right and just. Then His words are wasted on you...and you are dead...and those around you will probably suffer from your lack of faith.

Fear and the fearful

Of course, all the things in this paper are directed towards those who are part of the church of God. This is especially true of this unnumbered section because I am not addressing direct unbelief or those who have not made some effort towards God. This does not mean some of these things are not true for every human but it is incomplete and not entirely accurate for the world in general and is therefore not recommended for someone without any belief in the one true God. God has a different path for them and it is not your concern. And these words aren't a treatise anyway.

Fear affects us all and we have different ways of dealing with it. Here I am addressing fear unto death which is more extreme, but the treatment for all fear is the same and that is addressed as well. The first two scriptures below show the direct relationship of fear and faith and the third and fourth are related to the second death.

It is odd that there are those that understand parts of the word of God and believe the words that are said. *But in believing and understanding this knowledge* they do **not** have faith in Him or trust Him. This really odd combination creates persons whose understanding and belief do **not** create, yield or grow faith. Something must grow, but without faith nothing can be truly generated except fear. But part of it is developmental too among those with the spirit.

"And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no faith?"

And he saith unto them, Why are ye **fearful**, O ye of **little faith**? Then he arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm.

"But a certain **fearful** looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries."

"But the **fearful**, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death."

Be not fearful but <u>full of faith in God</u> lest you be thrown first into the lake of fire with those who die the 2^{nd} death. The energies of your knowledge and understanding and belief can go three different ways.

Towards faith choosing LIFE.

Towards fear choosing DEATH.

Towards denial choosing DEATH.

"I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you **life** and **death**, blessing and cursing: **therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:**"

Choosing life requires several choices and decisions that are absolutely critical and important. Making those correct choices when faced with them for the first time, makes it much easier to make those correct choices a way of life; choosing that good thing every time or as close to it as men are able.

Choosing faith and life lead to a short chain of mental/emotional events that actually is quite

formulaic in nature and goes like this.

Face your fears > Convert fear into faith in God > yielding power, love and a sound mind > yielding unity with God and His will, making your action obvious in a given circumstance (there are other factors to this basic formula but it is a basis)

And this works EVERY time. If **you** do it, ahem...faithfully.

There are a few things that are very important to note about converting fear into faith. Humility is a necessary ingredient that should be added always and forever. Pride and sin will cause the recipe to fail every time without exception, usually yielding hypocrisy. Faith in God requires absolute belief and trust in God and this is the basis of calmness and soundness of mind. This basic trust means that we don't have to face our fears alone but can share them first with God and far secondarily others of faith though these may be and are the same in many circumstances. This allows us to distribute and dissipate fear and when an acute great fear or terror is before us...according to the measure of our faith; can knock it down to a size that we can effectively fight the fear but also the effects of adrenaline and other chemicals coursing through our physical body. If it is a chronic fear generated by some longer term issue we are grappling with...this trust in God will reduce that fear and also greatly reduce the stress associated with it or remove it altogether in true faith as the fear leaves following the resolution to the sin (see also long term fear below). Faith is the great fear and stress reducer and is far, far stronger with the spirit of God in power. In cases where God has given His spirit in great measure...fear doesn't even enter in, under certain circumstances. Even Jesus sweat blood, under what are the worst possible conditions... unquestionable knowing in detail and waiting for that known horrible detail. Yet was He faithful. And would have suffered no lasting ill effect had the inevitable not occurred. But normally the process above is the way in which we can internally convert this evil thing into a righteous thing and it may be instantaneous or with smaller belief...slower and inconsistent. The blessings are self evident when you feel that freedom from fear and/or the courage and strength to face it or both. Note also, that fear and sin cohabit but this is not the place to discuss pure guilt or other related topics. Fear can mix with almost anything to generate all kinds of nasty effects on the faithful and unfaithful. Nevertheless, both must be faced and confronted and both are dissipated and converted to faith by belief in the spirit through confession to God and/or his true body...the true church.

If the solution above seems like I didn't actually answer how to convert fear to faith...then you need to realize that A. knowing the antidote is one key to solving the problem and B. that which is missing is within your own brain and it is personal and you are the one who can explain the inner workings of your own brain on this level...figure it out.

Read the Bible. Seek God while He may be found. Fear God, not men. Fear God and sin not! Fear God and learn wisdom. Don't do things that God hates. Know what God hates. Study Job and understand it. Study lamentations hoping to understand it. Judge righteous judgment. Love God for being the ONLY one willing and able to give you a way out of fear and death.

Choosing fear unto death is scary and is a fast or slow descent into greater and greater fear which may manifest as another emotion. It has it's ups and downs and can be almost forgotten occasionally with time but this is not the rule. The only way out of this is to go back and face your original choice and circumstance. Learn to face fear and convert it to something else. Barring that, there is no telling which direction any given person will eventually choose...catatonia or violent aggressive attacks on others or....ask a psychologist if you want a list...

"So that my soul chooseth strangling, and death rather than my life."

When we fail initially or in falling down with smaller choices we can become bogged down in a

variety of problems that usually accompany frustration and fear. Frustration is fear but twisted about with something else we are grappling with and most frequently focused upon self...and spread to others like a transmissible disease. That something else, may be one or many different things but sin is virtually always present even if only in lack of patience. We are usually frustrated with ourselves and those close to us and annoyed with ourselves or those not close. This is a manipulation of words without solid truth but serves to mildly show the distinction between fear and anger. Two emotions very closely related. Anger is the child of fear and violence is the child of anger. Frustration is mixed fear before it becomes annovance or outright anger. Frustration can be any size and may become gigantic if we don't allow it to convert to annoyance or anger. Annoyance is more anger than fear. In any case, we have within us the natural controls that any person has, to control our emotions. Every one of us is different with varying abilities. These things are not directly related to faith and do not require God to exercise. God created us and gave us the 'spirit in man' which engages naturally with those things which are in the brains of any animal. Animals control their emotions too...this is obvious from any cage of monkeys. You can watch them choose which way they are going to go emotionally according to given stimuli and results vary. Humans are more complex and the 'spirit in man' combined with true reason, long memory and emotional depth yield a vast field of possible negative outlets for converting fear. Only a relative few of them are higher on this spectrum and neutral or somewhat healthy to mind and body. But fear always leaves artifacts unless converted to true faith. True faith is not common and thus the church of God in this time is plagued by the same problems as everyone else, sometimes in greater measure because of contributing factors which I will not go into here.

Long term fear held close daily will result in stress and anxiety which is a longer term fear on a shortish leash that chews our insides within the bounds we permit and usually stays around because of our ignorance of how to proceed or lack of the desire to proceed even if we know the proper course. This type of condition may be from a acute events or it may come from ideas or information which the mind processes into fear and anxiety and stress. These fear related 'problems' result in longer term likelihood of physical sickness and disease as well as negative psychiatric conditions. These conditions are the twisted up remains of fear and guilt and many other emotions based on fear and are the playground of devils and demon possession. These are frequently progressive and worse cases usually result from large quantities of encapsulated fear which is usually hidden and cultivated into obsession and it's large and extended family. None of these places are places that you or anybody else wants to be. The cures for them once acquired are not necessarily simple whether you choose God or psychiatry. There is hope in God. Psychiatry has drugs that change symptoms and may mitigate them temporarily but the ends thereof are death. At this time and in this place...ooooof...but you know what they say about faith.

Choosing denial is choosing fear but merely mortgages most of it for another time like a great leaky boat. Denial makes you hard and flinty and nothing at all sticks to you. You are brittle and ready to shatter but few around you know this. True and actual disbelief of God is your strength though your lips are always full of His praise in falsity. You often hold the purse strings and control the money but not always. In fact, you may have great pride in the opposite. False love and other emotions *that embrace your particular brand of sin*, is your favorite daily beverage; but you have not an iota of sympathy for the sin of anyone else though you may condescendingly pity all those around you for their lack of righteousness. All these things are the ESSENCE of hypocrisy. Everything is a problem not your own and the sin of someone else and you exist on artificial buoyancy. Lies and blame become the default as you attempt to keep your boat afloat and not take on water. Reality blurs and then morphs, as your reality and the only important things to you, are puffed up, swelling out of proportion to reality and indeed the only thing you can see is your own false reality because you are blind to everything but your own Godhood and greatness...Oh and false modesty because, of course, you don't have any pride. You are a great actor because you must be to manage to prevent others from seeing the

inside of your cup. Shell-games are one of your specialties. Others become merely servants of your obsession and are punished for rocking the boat. Your mantra is, absolutely, "don't rock <u>MY</u> boat." Maintaining your own status quo is your every desire and your tongue becomes the sting of a wasp and the fangs of a viper and dipped in powdered sugar when you feel like it, so your victims sometimes doubt they have been stabbed and poisoned by you. You usually do well in a Babylonian lifestyle because you are conceited, bossy and hold everyone else to your standard, primarily because you were forced to develop many standards in order to supplant God...but your standards are lower than Gods and draped on everything in sight...binding heavy burdens upon those you consider your minions and under your power because of your lies...you are unwilling to even consider carrying any of these burdens and will invent new standards whenever necessary to avoid this.

But evil does come to a bad end and now shall be your perplexity...

When your boat actually does sink...which it always will unless dry-docked in the port of Faith...it is an enormous surprise and shock and all that fear you mortgaged earlier comes back in an enormous rush of disbelief and horror and mind-numbing psychic pain of fear and is closely followed by death and/or hideous psychiatric problems or should I say demonic problems. In this time and this place...yep death. It can all be circumvented by believing God in true faith. But if you have become that much of a hypocrite...then you have created your own prison and STRONG are the bars of reinforced pride that won't let you out. In this advanced case, God certainly doesn't want you and most of the people you know secretly don't either and would prefer your first or 2nd death. If you don't believe this...you don't know your Bible very well at all. And, you usually know just enough about the word of God to win most of your arguments with the largely ignorant; and misquote enough scripture to fill your own grave. You fall back on belittling or attempting to humiliate anyone who disagrees with you. As with all things sinful, faith, repentance and humility followed by obedience is the only balm. Hypocrites can only find faith through true humility and the actual breaking down of their idol...as they have all categorically chosen their own judgment above God just as Adam and Eve did eating the forbidden fruit. "Oh really, that's preposterous! They couldn't possibly be dying of the same thing...Christ came and fixed that..." Indeed He did come and became the door...that doesn't mean that everyone walks through it even if they claim to...and teach everyone else around them to do so. It is really easy to eat anew of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil and prove that your judgment is better than God. This sets them up above God and makes them false Christs. They always teach something other than what God has spoken, though it sounds similar enough that the mind numbingly ignorant minions don't realize it is the opposite in many cases. Hmmm...so when the blind and those blind they are leading all fall in the pit...do those poor...uh innocent...minion fools following the blind leaders actually have to die and burn in hell? Answer: unconditionally YES! Reason: because their innocence was really ignorance and they were complicit in their deaths due to...well...ignorance, stupidity, negligence, a large portion of naivete, and disobedience. And they ask me... "wherein have we sinned?" And I say...start here...you are also noting the amount of times that God has absolute control of the removal or nonremoval of sins

25 I, even I, am he that blotteth out thy transgressions for mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins.

33 And they have turned unto me the back, and not the face: though I taught them, rising up early and teaching them, yet they have not hearkened to receive instruction.

8 And I will cleanse them from all their iniquity, whereby they have sinned against me; and I will pardon all their iniquities, whereby they have sinned, and whereby they have transgressed against me.

The sinners in Zion are afraid; fearfulness hath surprised the hypocrites. Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? who among us shall dwell with everlasting burnings?

15 He that walketh righteously, and speaketh uprightly; he that despiseth the gain of oppressions, that shaketh his hands from holding of bribes, that stoppeth his ears from hearing of blood, and shutteth his eyes from seeing evil; And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the Lord: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.

And the inhabitant shall not say, I am sick: the people that dwell therein shall be forgiven their iniquity.

23 Because they have committed villary in Israel, and have committed adultery with their neighbours' wives, and have spoken lying words in my name, which I have not commanded them; even I know, and am a witness, saith the Lord.

My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee

Who can read these scriptures and then think that all they have to do is call upon the name of the Lord in *this* time and all their sins will just be forgiven and that they are perfect and righteous before God? Those who say these things are liars and there is no truth in them! *Blessed is the man to whom God imputes no sin!*

And back to that fear and a bit of doctrine... The deception leading to sin is virtually always soft and gentle and a lie believed and colluded with, because hypocrites are most definitely front-runners in any popularity contest. I could put hundreds of scriptures in all through this section but I think in this case it would mask the actual reality. It's not hard to crack a Bible and look up a few words on the internet to find scriptures about hypocrites and how much God hates them. Almost nobody will do this though because they are just too lazy to find out what God really has to say about people that for some odd and mysterious reason God's people look up to. Stockholm Syndrome?

In reality it is related to one of the biggest problems in the church today. And, believe it or not that is doctrinal understanding. It doesn't matter what church you go to, or what church you visit...there is always a statement of beliefs or some such that tells you clearly what they believe and what is important to them. It is a statement that says we are this way and this is good and you better be like this or you are not going to last here! And while it is all well and good to have doctrine bedded firmly on that Rock which is Christ...this is not truly the purpose of those statements...what they say to me, and much more importantly God...is...we are righteous! See, we do the things we are supposed to! Just look and you can tell that we are righteous because WE are following the TRUE doctrine of God and we're BETTER than those other SINNERS who don't have their doctrines RIGHT! Come and follow us and give us your money and we will make you just like us...RIGHTEOUS and the TRUE church with good doctrine. Etc. etc. and we will definitely make you two-fold more the child of hell than ourselves!!!!

This is, in fact, a sign they have hung out that says we are poor and blind and naked and without an iota

of understanding of what God actually wants from His people. God has 7 churches and they all have different doctrines. And some are horrible and He holds those doctrines against them. The Seventh day Adventists have Jezebel and the Laodiceans and others have the Rapture... and all of them split hairs over and over and over fighting and seeking advantage against the others in the doctrinal wars. In fact, God isn't all that interested in this business; for a variety of reasons, primarily because it is a business, a way to make money by the moneychangers in the house of God but also because NOTHING about it brings about that which He DOES SEEK...a broken and contrite spirit. Arguing about doctrinal issues right or wrong just reinforces your own belief that you are RIGHT and therefore righteous in your own eyes. It swells you up like a puff adder and brings out your fangs to bite and tear those around you. I don't much discuss the important things of God with people who speak of doctrine as their savior. There is no point in even speaking with them. They are righteous in their own eyes and hypocrites to the core, having all they want of God, not knowing what they will actually receive.

"Yet let no man strive, nor reprove another: for thy people are as they that strive with the priest."

And if you haven't figured it out already...arguing with the priest or a minister, or anyone excited about being right about doctrine...yields just about the same result as arguing with a policeman. And yes this is partially a repeat...for good reason.

Because ye have said, We have made a covenant with death, and with hell are we at agreement; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, it shall not come unto us: for we have made lies our refuge, and under falsehood have we hid ourselves: Judgment also will I lay to the line, and righteousness to the plummet: and the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the hiding place. 18 And your covenant with death shall be disannulled, and your agreement with hell shall not stand; when the <u>overflowing</u> scourge shall pass through, then ye shall be trodden down by it. And the vision of all is become unto you as the words of a book that is sealed, which men deliver to one that is learned, saying, Read this, I pray thee: and he saith, I cannot; for it is sealed: 12 And the book is delivered to him that is not learned, saying, Read this, I pray thee: and he saith, I am not learned. 13 Wherefore the Lord said, Forasmuch as this people draw near me with their mouth, and with their lips do honour me, but have removed their heart far from me, and their fear toward me is taught by the precept of men: 14 Therefore, behold, I will proceed to do a marvellous work among this people, even a marvellous work and a wonder: for the wisdom of their wise men shall perish, and the understanding of their prudent men shall be hid. 15 Woe unto them that seek deep to hide their counsel from the Lord, and their works are in the dark, and they say, Who seeth us? and who knoweth us?

Woe to the rebellious children, saith the Lord, that take counsel, but not of me; and that cover with a covering, but not of my spirit, that they may add sin to sin:

That this is a rebellious people, lying children, children that will not hear the law of the Lord:

10 Which say to the seers, See not; and to the prophets, Prophesy not unto us right things, speak unto us smooth things, prophesy deceits: For thus saith the

Lord God, the Holy One of Israel; <u>In returning and rest shall ye be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength: and ye would not.</u>

Have ye not known? have ye not heard? hath it not been told you from the beginning? have ye not understood from the foundations of the earth?

But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

For <u>out of Jerusalem shall go forth a remnant</u>, and <u>they that escape out of mount Zion</u>: the zeal of the Lord of hosts shall do this.

Nobody knows the Judgment of God except by the Word of Jesus Christ which is the Testimony of God which is the Spirit of Prophecy. And by prophecy we know the Judgment of God, for in prophecy He judges the whole earth and all its peoples and gives a record of His Judgment <u>before</u> the time He rises up to judge! Obviously, understanding prophecy gives an edge in understanding not only the future but God's righteous judgment. He that is righteous, will judge rightly and not according to the sight of man but of the understanding of God into the future unto the return of Jesus Christ. And these are the things that confront you in prophecy...

He shall judge thy people with righteousness, and thy poor with judgment... He shall judge the poor of the people, he shall save the children of the needy, and shall break in pieces the oppressor.

But with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and he shall smite the earth: with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked.

Because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead.

Do ye not know that the saints shall judge the world? and if the world shall be judged by you, are ye unworthy to judge the smallest matters?

But when we are judged, we are chastened of the Lord, that we should not be condemned with the world.

Be in pain, and labour to bring forth, O daughter of Zion, like a woman in travail: for now shalt thou go forth out of the city, and thou shalt dwell in the field, and thou shalt go even to Babylon; there shalt thou be delivered; there the Lord shall redeem thee from the hand of thine enemies.

What thing shall I take to witness for thee? what thing shall I liken to thee, O daughter of Jerusalem? what shall I equal to thee, that I may comfort thee, O virgin daughter of Zion? for thy breach is great like the sea: who can heal thee? Thy prophets have seen vain and foolish things for thee: and they have not discovered thine iniquity, to turn away thy captivity; but have seen for thee false burdens and causes of banishment.

I will not punish your daughters when they commit whoredom, nor your spouses when they commit adultery: for themselves are separated with whores, and they sacrifice with harlots: therefore the people that doth not understand shall fall.

Babylon hath been a golden cup in the Lord's hand, that made all the earth drunken: the nations have drunken of her wine; therefore the nations are mad. <u>Babylon is suddenly fallen and destroyed</u>: howl for her; take balm for her pain, if so be she may be healed. We would have healed Babylon, but she is not healed: forsake her, and let us go every one into his own country: for <u>her judgment reacheth unto heaven</u>, and is lifted up even to the skies. The Lord hath brought forth our

righteousness: come, and let us declare in Zion the work of the Lord our God. Make bright the arrows; gather the shields: the Lord hath raised up the spirit of the kings of the Medes: for his device is against Babylon, to destroy it; because it is the vengeance of the Lord, the vengeance of his temple. Set up the standard upon the walls of Babylon, make the watch strong, set up the watchmen, prepare the ambushes: for the Lord hath both devised and done that which he spake against the inhabitants of Babylon. O thou that dwellest upon many waters, abundant in treasures, thine end is come, and the measure of thy covetousness. The Lord of hosts hath sworn by himself, saying, Surely I will fill thee with men, as with caterpillers; and they shall lift up a shout against thee.

And I will render unto Babylon and to all the inhabitants of Chaldea all their evil that they have done in Zion in your sight, saith the Lord. Behold, I am against thee, O destroying mountain, saith the Lord, which destroyest all the earth: and I will stretch out mine hand upon thee, and roll thee down from the rocks, and will make thee a burnt mountain.

And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, <u>Come out of her, my people</u>, <u>that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.</u>

Deliver thyself, O Zion, that dwellest with the daughter of Babylon.

My people, go ye out of the midst of her, and deliver ye every man his soul from the fierce anger of the Lord.

<u>Flee out of the midst of Babylon</u>, and deliver every man his soul: be not cut off in her iniquity; for this is the **time of the Lord's vengeance**; he will render unto her a recompence.

The voice of them that flee and escape out of the land of Babylon, to declare in Zion the vengeance of the Lord our God, the vengeance of his temple.

Therefore thus saith the Lord God, Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious corner stone, a sure foundation: he that believeth shall not make haste.

"And in her was found the blood of prophets, and of saints, and of <u>all</u> that were slain upon the earth. And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God: For true and righteous are his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand. And again they said, Alleluia And her smoke rose up for ever and ever."

Twenty First, or something like that... a concise comment I posted somewhere,

@ randomperson and anyone else who said something I may have missed...There is much to say of the end time and of the temple of God and the people of God. Relating to the Jews...everybody misunderstands the difference between the Jews and the lost twelve tribes... They lump them together in error because of ignorance. The Jews are about half and half in America and Israel. The lost twelve tribes are mostly those people who call themselves the churches of God here in America. They are almost completely ignorant of most of the important things that they should know about God and themselves. The will learn or die in ignorance. The Bible in it's entirety, was written for those upon whom the ends of the age are come. The big problem is that people cannot understand because they have not really truly sought God and read His word as though their lives depended on it. If they had, they would know exactly who the people of God are and where they are and what it means to be grafted in. When you are grafted in you become part of the tree and for all intents and purposes are indistinguishable from the native parts of the tree. Were they not ignorant they would know that there is a physical temple and a spiritual temple and a heavenly temple and that the last physical temple was destroyed 2k years ago and will be rebuilt again by the two witnesses and that the spiritual temple is the

church of God, which is the body of Christ which is being built by God into a functional and perfect body/temple spiritually made up of individual stones/people that will be rescued and avenged at the proper time and is represented in the books of the prophets by the names Jerusalem and Zion and names containing these and that they are distinctly, distinct from and almost unrelated to the Jews in this time but that they will be reunited relatively soon and they would also know that Jerusalem and Zion dwell in captivity to the daughter of Babylon in this end time and they would also know that Babylon is made up of 5 distinct parts broken down in time from Dan 2 and Nebuchadnezzar and the head of Gold...silver...brass...the legs of iron of Rome and the feet of iron and miry clay which is America and they would also know that this is the time and place of the stone that strikes the feet and shatters all Babylon for all time and makes her a burnt mountain cast into the sea. The heavenly temple is, of course, the temple that God has built/is building in heaven that comes down upon the new heavens and the new earth after death and hell and all the enemies of God are put down and the millennium is finished Rev 20 something. And yes...I have told you several mysteries and one Great Mystery. He that has an ear let him hear...and not be ignorant... as to posting scriptures...hmmm...a lot of work for relatively little joy...there are other things that you should understand before this will be of much use to you. If you send me your email address somehow privately (not sure how you do that here) I will send anyone who is part of one of the churches of God things that I have written in pdf or odf related to these subjects. I don't charge money for the words of God. Work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.

The fear of God is the beginning of wisdom!

Twenty-secondish, The following is a letter written about various things. I have included it here in it's entirety with only a few tiny edits and a name change because it addresses a number of issues that are relevant to the prophetic.

Hi Somebody,

No worries I enjoyed reading them. And don't worry about time or expectation with me. I have none. If you believe the words that I have written, you believe God inasmuch as I have faithfully brought the spirit and meaning of the word of God. You can see and feel in the spirit and the word of God, spoken in truth, stirs you, I know. But the things I have written in many cases also challenge many lies that you have taken for truth. So do not be troubled unduly and take your time to rightly divide the word of truth and prove all things!!! I also have motion and inertia on my side as I have been considering and writing about a number of fairly complex matters for some time. By that I just mean it flows easily through exercise and because it is easy for me to see.

The Bible is, as you know, scripture by individual scripture, and is multi-faceted and written that way intentionally so that the unclean cannot easily understand it nor soil it. Only those with the spirit of God...who soil it too often unfortunately. It is easy to get lost in the ...Oooh Sparkly... over one thing or another and get deer in the headlight syndrome to others; to mix metaphors. It is extraordinarily easy to find passages in the prophets that absolutely pin down a given context, time and perhaps the identity (ies) of the player(s) and not be able to understand anything around that sentence or the verses around it and you may even recognize other contexts and times that seem to conflict or just be bizarre. Lots of facets, reflecting and refracting many things. It is mesmerizing and confusing and difficult to understand even when you aren't reading the prophets. Most of the time now, I can read most of the prophets and the various threads and weaves and times and people and the sparkles and shines kind of flow through showing their various truths and contexts in an almost 3d cinematic way. It's not always that way and depending on focus or strength of spirit in the moment it may be simpler or more complex. Sometimes there are the blanknesses of a thing not understood and I explore these and ponder them and sometimes they resolve and sometimes they wait...never forced. The problem is that

you can't truly understand either the "new" or the "old" (testaments?) without each other as they set the context for each other and whether acknowledged or not it is all prophetic. It can be a bit like the chicken and the egg. As I have grown, I have learned to understand that there is **nothing** in the Bible that is not prophetic. And there is nothing of true prophecy that is not of faith. Just like whatsoever is **<u>not</u>** of faith is sin... For me, this began at a young age, by actually believing what I read in the Bible and defending those things I understood (usually in my head), when others, regardless of who they were, said things to the contrary. If you believe lies about God or allow others to pull the wool over your eyes for your or their comfort and don't see Him as He has faithfully and truthfully recorded for us in His word...how can He give truth or further truth through His spirit. For you have believed a lie! The basis for understanding truth is believing truth and knowing it from lies. Never let go of truth and always be looking for other truth or deeper truth within what you already know is truth. You have no need that any man teach you! And this you know also, as a hard won truth. Most truth that has come into my life has been 1. in the Bible. 2. brought to me by the spirit in the Bible. 3. brought to me in the spirit...usually when thinking about the Bible. The WORD of God whether paper or spoken by man or corporeal in the body of Christ is the source of all truth. There is no other. This also defines righteousness. In any case...there has to be a foundation to start stacking individual truths into a bigger picture. It ALL fits together because God is unified and cohesive, truly ONE. No truth is random and it all forms a pattern or really many patterns within patterns within larger patterns and more also. As you build and start to see accurate pictures you get better at sorting the various true puzzle pieces and understand how they fit together. With exercise this makes it extraordinarily easy to spot lies and error both. You know this and have experienced it in some things. Many people have no patience for waiting for truth or understanding, and some, fudge and invent profundity...obviously false. Oh, how many things I could say here! but I will not regress... Doing this breaks their foundation and obviously destroys everything they were/are trying to do. Thus daubing untempered mortar. I try to face the truth **head on** in every circumstance regardless of what it may or may not do to me, good or bad, perception or reality, internal or external. Obviously, I don't always succeed, nobody can, but it gets better and faster and greater as the spirit is freed to flow in any truth for this is the path of the spirit and how it flows.

Most people can't understand prophecy because when they read all the terrible things that God accuses His own people of doing...they are unwilling to put their own face in the picture as guilty. And without doing that, they don't have the patience or the inclination to actually understand the accusations that God levels against us, nor see their true solution. They default to mucking about ineffectually in what has become the great sandbox of the blood of Christ. "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee," They can't relate the words for the various sins written in the prophets to the everyday things that we all do in this "modern" life that God accuses us of. (the effort required to fix this sentence structure is just too great right now...ugh)

Well really, what's wrong with having a retirement account? Uh...duh...it makes you a usurer.

Working the stock market makes you someone who takes "gain" a small word that God uses with scathing scorn.

And there are many, many more. And those two examples were chosen specifically for a reason, that being that almost everyone is guilty except the very poorest...and these examples relate to money. Money to a true Christian is almost the least important thing there is... If you can't be trusted with money as a very small thing how can you be trusted with so much more? This is obviously a vague paraphrase of Christ. The point is that we are by and large not faithful with the least of things...how can He trust us with the greatest of things? How many ways would we fail? In the churches of God one of

the greatest stumbling blocks is money. We have the sheepthieves and sheepmerchants because of this. We also have the poor of the flock and it is those skinny ones that have been taken advantage of, over and over and over and have proven to God that they are true sheep who will hear His voice and with difficulty try not to harm those around them or take others captive and steal from them. It is to these that I come bearing food to strengthen. For how will the daughter of Zion arise and thresh having neither understanding nor strength?

You know as well as I do, that Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever... If He didn't like it in the old testament times...He didn't like it in new testament times...and He doesn't like it now... Yes, all things may be done in faith. But God JUDGES who does what in faith and rewards people for their works whether in faith or error. When 'all these things' are done in faith...it is most frequently transitional...for a person to get from one point to another and that which God has declared sin is then set aside in faith to GOOD works not the continuation of evil works for their own sake. This does not mean that we go back and try to keep the whole law or rebuild the temple on our lawn...it means we follow Christ and avoid evil or its appearance whenever possible and whenever we recognize it. Because, when you remain in sins and evils...they multiply and have babies...not just babies but litters of babies with short gestation times which grow to have their own litters. And this is our circumstance in everything in America and the various states we live in and the cities we live in and the churches we go or don't go to and in most cases the houses we live in. You know this by casually looking anywhere around you on the news or wherever...and if you don't think you or the people around you participate in all this...you are mistaken and guilty and blind and deaf and ultimately dead. You know this and see it clearly because you have tried and in part succeeded in cleaning up yourselves and your houses and your churches...or should I say church now. :) But when you have enough baggage of sin dragging you down...whether you recognize them as sin or not...it makes it *almost* impossible to receive anything from God but a curse. The only way out of this is personal and individual and in the word of truth. And, it is even harder to understand or recognize and actually see all these horrible things because we have all been told and at least in part have believed that it is not sin anymore as it has been forgiven or fulfilled or God understands or whatever...yuck. Even though we wade about in it and try not to smell that which corrupts us. But we can all, also see that those works that shall surely follow have not and do not follow us with any regularity in this time or at least so rarely nobody is certain if it was God or a lie or an accident or the misreading of an MRI. Once again, I do not deny that all things can be done as a matter of faith or miracles of God in one circumstance or another...but that is not what is happening within the church and our nation today. We are ignorant of how God wants us to act and in ignorance we soil everything around us.

Once you have an accident in your drawers in someone else' house and are standing in a small room with poopy all over you, and your poopy drawers around your ankles and poop on both hands and the sink won't work in their half bath...it's pretty hard to get clean...no matter how hard you try! Everything stinks and is horrible and embarrasing and just icky. This is our reality and our challenge and our gift really...it is humiliating and if our attitude is right...humbling. For this is the membrane of purification we must pass through to cleanse our eyes of poop and sand and motes and tree trunks and it is humility. "He hath shewed thee, O man, what is good; and what doth the Lord require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God?" And this is what I do to the best of my ability in faith! Though as we all do, I carry the stench of the unclean with me everyday and as we all do not...I hate it with passion. Whenever possible...I shed the things which God hates and says against those of whom He prophesies...regardless of the identity of the people that God is speaking to. If God hates it; I don't want it. Full stop. No I'm not British but sometimes I wish there was a period the size of a grape that I could end sentences with... exclamations points just don't have the correct feel and yes...I did end a sentence, yet again, with a preposition. I associate exclamation points with volume of voice even if that may not technically be what they mean. I want something more like what a deaf person must feel standing next to Big Ben when it strikes. Wow...it's 1 am. I need to sleep I will take

this up tomorrow...gnight.

Nope 10 minutes later I had to come back and finish the...hmmm...thought... People can't face their blood guilt largely because we have been told over and over and over that we are the chosen and righteous people and God chose us because we are good and He loves us no matter what we do and etc. etc. etc. And while it is possible that this may be true in rather fewer cases...and not limiting the love of God...the attitude that we get from all that above, is not a broken and contrite spirit or the attitude of a child properly disciplined by loving parents which ends in true humility. It is pride and self congratulation and self adulation and the opposite of everything God wants.

There are 83 places in the Bible that you can casually find a phrase very similar to "and you shall know that I am the Lord!" Mostly in the prophets. I think I looked it up under "ye shall know" or something like that to find the most hits, but the point is people forget God or lose God or ignore God because of the opposite of humility. Our pride. The context of these scriptures is always punishment for pride and sin. You can't sin against God without rising up in pride against Him to do so...whether you are conscious of it or not. Disobedience is always preceded by an internal personal judgment that "I know better" and "my will be done;" this under the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. If you haven't had a chance to read what I wrote about the two trees yet, you should. But we don't know better and intellectually we mostly admit this...but stubborn pride and rebelliousness drive us to continue in our sin because in the end we don't really believe that our judgment is compromised. He had to tell us that 'He is Lord' over and over and over and over, ad nauseum, so that we might remember that He actually is the Lord! Repetition may be the best form of emphasis...yet are we deaf. And still, we don't know or remember! And...having told us He is Lord ad nauseum (to those who seek not His glory)...He is going to proceed to feed us our blood guilt, in blood unmeasureable, spilled all over us so that once we actually achieve the light bulb... eureka! We will actually remember it... just as holocaust survivors still <u>do</u>. Any excuse that we could possibly come up with to weasel out of our guilt will be wiped away utterly in blood. "Oh, come on, this is the new millenium...God fulfilled that...everybody does it. You can't exist in the modern world without doing ." There is no end to excuses and the bigger they are the more scripture someone has to explain away or gloss over or cover up. Which in the end amounts simply to a mountain of denials of God. "Well...He didn't really mean that...that would be too hard for us..." Yep, well maybe it is, but if you don't believe Him about any little thing how is it ever possible that you will believe that there actually is a Day of the Lord's Anger...Wrath...etc. etc. etc. until it arrives as a thief in the night to your utter shame. And I have once again sickened myself with the thought of that idiotic "Left Behind" rapture crap that everyone shallow and without understanding so love to embrace. And they shall know that He is the Lord when instead of whisking the hypocrites away into some imaginary place; someone rubs their nose in the lies and then men who burn the chaff come along and put 3 bullets in their guts and drop nuclear bombs all over their city... He had to write that most basic "you shall know that I am the Lord" down 83 times with nearly that exact phrase and undoubtedly hundreds more with different phraseaology... or we still wouldn't remember it...and then......we tend to concentrate on passages or topics in the Bible where there is/are only one or two scriptures about that topic in the whole Bible. Somewhere along the way we may have dabbled a bit in hypocrisy and studied up on Ostrich mentality. And frankly, I am sick to death of it. Most especially within myself. I am utterly heartsick of sand and poop and splinters in my eyes.

As for writing...well, I write when I am inspired to do so. Sometimes it is a lot and sometimes not. Sometimes it's early and sometimes it's late... as now. That other was a lot for one day and hopefully I didn't make many errors as I only read through it a couple times for content and typos. This is a relatively little and mostly much more casual and thus easier though I am editing it now the next morning. Maintaining the truth of various ideas through sentences and paragraphs or the lack thereof and punctuation and grammar and the whole English language...or the lack thereof; strains everything at the seams as often than not. I do, actually know, when I commit most of my crimes against the English language...and still I shamelessly punctuate recklessly and apparently adverbially late into the

night.

Ok, for real, I think I can go to bed now.

Or Not...

The prophetic word is kind of similar to a cactus patch with the glint of Eldorado in the middle of it. Perhaps I need to say no more...but...what's the fun in that? Reality is you can't understand prophecy if you aren't willing to shed your own blood and pride as a sacrifice for understanding. If you are unwilling to be pierced by conviction of sin your pride prevents you from comprehending the meaning of what is spoken of the future because you can't accept your guilt nor face the reality and blood of the future. I will add this unchanged into the main paper I am writing about prophecy. It is in an entirely different tone and focus but still conveys some important things viewed differently.

This is encouraging to me for its own sake but I hope that many may read these words and take warning and wake up and realize their circumstance and the sin they have been ignoring or denying. I will certainly be around to remind them whether they like it or not...through scorn and hatred and spit and through any nasty thing thrown at me verbally or otherwise.

This paper is a word of hope that could save your life...because if you don't face the reality of who God is and who you are and what is going to happen in your time because your God has prophesied and told you that it will happen and has given you His Word in the Bible and this and other words that points the direction of hope in this place and that it will happen to the rest of the world also and you will miss the Revelation of Jesus Christ because of your death and the deaths of all those around you who will not obey the voice of the Messiah. You cannot hide from it "he that fleeth of them shall not flee away, and he that escapeth of them shall not be delivered. Though they dig into hell, thence shall mine hand take them; though they climb up to heaven, thence will I bring them down: And though they hide themselves in the top of Carmel, I will search and take them out thence; and though they be hid from my sight in the bottom of the sea, thence will I command the serpent, and he shall bite them: And though they go into captivity before their enemies, thence will I command the sword, and it shall slay them: and I will set mine eyes upon them for evil, and not for good." It will come for you and if you can see it... You will know what to do. You will begin to obey the Lord of hosts **NOW** before He hides Himself completely. And and you will search for Him and seek Him. Anything less than now...is too late. If you do not, misery, utter misery and death. - **46** Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.
- 15 And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth.
- 16 And he spake a parable unto them, saying, The ground of a certain rich man brought forth plentifully:
- 17 And he thought within himself, saying, What shall I do, because I have no room where to bestow my fruits?
- 18 And he said, This will I do: I will pull down my barns, and build greater; and there will I bestow all my fruits and my goods.
